COURSES IN 2012:

As mentioned above, the new timetable and course information pack for our **January 2012 classes** are now available - if you require further details or wish to re-enrol then please contact a member of the Lorca staff in reception and they will be happy to help. A quick reminder of the enrolment process:

1. Please **complete the re-enrolment form and hand it in to a member of staff in reception.** You can do this before your class starts/at break time or any other day during the week that suits you (Monday-Friday between 10.00-6.00pm or Saturday mornings between 10.00am and 12.30pm). Alternatively you can re-enrol over the phone.
2. **Payment:** when you hand in your form you can opt to pay either the **£25.00 deposit** (which will book your place on the course) or the full fee. A discount of **£10.00** is available for all current students who pay the full fee on or before **Friday 16th December** (not applicable to concessions or family discounts)
3. **Existing classes will be going forward into the next term:** please note that we will only contact you in the event of a class change/cancellation: otherwise you should assume that the class you enrolled in is going ahead. A class would only be cancelled if we had insufficient numbers of people enrolling for the next term.
